

Job Description – Class 1 Driver

Position Title:	Class 1 Driver

Position Summary:

The Class 1 Driver is responsible for operating heavy transport equipment used in the company's daily environments, and includes the use and care of roll off trucks, wastewater trucks, tractors, lowbed trailers, B-Trains and other transport equipment.

Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate heavy transport equipment for company related activities.
- Help staff with labour related duties when a machine is not required for the job
- Adhere to applicable safety and environmental standards, regulations, and company policies
- Ensure equipment is kept clean
- Perform pre/post-operation safety checks
- General daily equipment maintenance, such as greasing, checking and monitoring fluid levels, reporting machine hours and service requirements
- Flexible scheduling (afternoon shift, night shift), may be required
- Other duties as required.
