Your duties may include (determined by COVID safety protocols):

- Sharing information and the story about the renaming of SMONEĆTEN Campground
- Assisting in the preparation and delivery of the SMONEĆTEN Coast Salish campfire program. You will join other interpreters and W̱SÁNEĆ storytellers, who share the SENĆOŦEN language with visitors.
- Connecting visitors with the Salish Sea by offering interpretative stories/activities/ programs around Gulf Islands National Park Reserve
- You will work collaboratively with others on the team

Term: Approximately mid May to the end of August 2021

WHAT YOU NEED TO HAVE

Job Requirements:

- Valid class 5 driver's license (or working towards)
- Age range: 18-29
- Experience working with the public
- Connection with W̱SÁNEĆ heritage (such as SENĆOŦEN language learner/speaker, storyteller)
- Ability to work with computers or willing to learn, including Microsoft Office tools such as email, Excel and Word

WHAT YOU NEED TO BE AWARE OF

- You will need reliable transportation to and from Parks Canada office in Sidney
- You will need a Status security clearance (We will do this at time of hiring)
- You will use safe work practices and required personal protective clothing (training and terms of use provided)
- You will wear a Parks Canada uniform,
- You will work outdoors and stand/walk for extended periods of time (sometimes in bad weather)
- You will work shift-work, weekends, evening, overtime and statutory holidays
- You will set-up, take-down and move equipment (including large and heavy equipment, tables and tents)
