Position Summary:

The Class 1 Driver is responsible for operating heavy transport equipment used in the company daily environments including roll off trucks, Wastewater truck, tractor, lowbed, B-Train and other transport equipment used in the daily operations of the company. <u>We are willing to train the right person for the job.</u>

Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate heavy transport equipment within company related operational activities.
- Help staff with labour related duties when a machine is not required for the job.
