Position: Our not-for-profit, community-based organization is looking for a reliable and hardworking individual to join our dynamic, diverse and committed team as a **Part-time Sanitation & Cleaning Custodian**.

Responsibilities include:

- Vacuum carpets, area rug, upholstered furniture
- Clean, disinfect and polish bathrooms, team room/break room surfaces, sink and appliances
- Clean and disinfect facility surfaces including counters, railings and ledges
- Floor duties sweep, mop, wash floors, hallways and stairs
- Empty trash cans, recycling and other waste containers
- Wash windows and doors at entrance and exit areas
- Dust furnishings (lights, window sills, and air vents)
- Other maintenance duties and required
- Periodic high dusting of lights and air vents

Requirements:

- Successful applicants will have to undergo the necessary background checks
- Good communication skills and attention to detail
- Relevant experience is preferred but not a must as we will provide all necessary training and supplies
- Ability to lift at least 50lbs
- Ability to climb ladders, step ladders and scaffolding
