#### JOB DESCRIPTION

As an organization focused on self-determination, the WSÁNEĆ Leadership Council (WLC) works to enhance recognition of, and respect for, WSÁNEĆ Douglas Treaty rights and WSÁNEĆ Aboriginal rights and title on behalf of Tsartlip First Nation, Tsawout First Nation, and Tseycum First Nation.

The QENTOL, YEN / WSÁNEĆ Marine Guardians program is looking to hire a Marine Data Analyst fulltime. The Marine Data Analyst (MDA) will work under the direction of the Southern Resident Killer Whale Senior Manager. The MDA will work on specific areas already determined to be important with the work we plan to carry out. This position is central to the QENTOL, YEN / WSÁNEĆ Marine Guardians program involvement with DFO- Fisheries and Oceans Canada in providing foundational work to support the Southern Resident Killer Whale monitoring program.

The successful applicant will be asked to demonstrate a combination of skills and experience related to the marine environment and its ecological uses. MDA will work on the following: develop and entering a variety data information through EMSA (Enhanced Maritime Situational Awareness), Trail Mark and data gathered on Monitoring Southern Resident Killer Whale, other fisheries data and other data programs such as;

- Access public information data layers;
- Marine traffic data;
- o AIS (Automatic Information Session) real time data: tracking vessels in area;
- o DFO Fisheries and Oceans Canada data;
- Base line data gathering;
- Mapping: such as commercial & traditional harvesting sites;
- Create maps & reports as required from either Marine Department or WSÁNEĆ Leadership Council;
- Other task may be assigned as the QENTOL, YEN / WSÁNEĆ Marine Guardians is growing.

The successful applicant needs to be comfortable disseminating information as well as have strong active listening skills. Ability to seat at a desk to analyze data for long periods at a time. The successful candidate will work as a member of our QENTOL, YEN / WSÁNEĆ Marine Guardians, while fulfilling existing and upcoming project obligations.

- High-level written and verbal communication skills
- Demonstrated skills and experience in report writing and mapping
- Ability to analyze existing tools and databases and provide software solution recommendations
- Ability to translate business requirements into non-technical, lay terms
- Must have a current update Class 5 Driver's License
- Knowledge of Aboriginal rights, Douglas Treaty rights, and WSÁNEĆ culture will be considered assets



The successful candidate will work full-time from the QENTOL, YEN/ WSÁNEĆ Marine Guardians Office in Brentwood Bay. Furthermore, the candidate will need to be self-directed, thorough, and able to work efficiently in an environment with competing priorities.
