### Position Summary:

The Class 1 Driver is responsible for operating heavy transport equipment used in the company daily environments including roll off trucks, Wastewater truck, tractor, lowbed, B-Train and other transport equipment used in the daily operations of the company. We are willing to train the right person for the job.

### Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate heavy transport equipment within company related operational activities.
- Help staff with labour related duties when a machine is not required for the job.
- Flexible scheduling (afternoon shift, night shift).
- Adhere to applicable safety and environmental standards, regulations and company policies.
- Ensure equipment is kept clean.
- Ensure pre/post safety pre-trips are performed.
- General daily equipment maintenance, such as greasing, checking and monitoring fluid levels, reporting machine hours and serving requirements.
