



## Sidney Island Ecological Restoration Project: Fall Planting Event in the Park Reserve

**WHAT:** Planting native and culturally-significant plants on Sidney Island, to restore the forest understory and support future Indigenous harvesting in the park reserve.

**WHO:** SIERP project representatives, WSÁNEĆ and Pauquachin community members – up to 10 people per day.

- Must be capable of walking up to 2km over uneven terrain
- Must have appropriate clothing and footwear for the weather conditions
- **No planting or restoration experience necessary!** Training will be provided on-site.
- Must be prepared to follow COVID-19 safety guidelines.
- **Lunch, snacks, and drinks will be provided.**
